Developing Leaders

More than just financial support, leadership development is a key component of the Cargill Global Scholars Program. During the program, participants are provided with various opportunities to enhance their leadership skills.

- Program Year 1 – All participants take part in a fully-funded three day leadership seminar
- Program Year 2 – Students from each country cohort will participate in a Global Leadership Program at one of Cargill's global locations, with an opportunity to network with other students as well as Cargill leaders

Each Cargill Global Scholar will be paired with a Cargill leader as their mentor for the duration of the program. The mentorship support includes goal setting exercises, work and networking opportunities. This is achieved through face-to-face contact and regular email and phone communication.

Following program completion, participants become members of the Cargill Global Scholars alumni community – a global network of peers with a common vision.

Who Can Apply?

In order to be selected for an award, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Citizen of the country in which you apply
- Enrolled in one of the partner universities in Indonesia: IPB, UB, UGM, UNAND, UNHAS, UNILA and UNS
- Second year undergraduate student in Accounting (preference in Makassar area), Agriculture Related Field, Biology, Electrical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, or Mechanical Engineering
- Demonstrate high academic performance
- Involvement in social and student activities and showing leadership potential
- Demonstrate financial need
- Women and difable are strongly encouraged to apply
